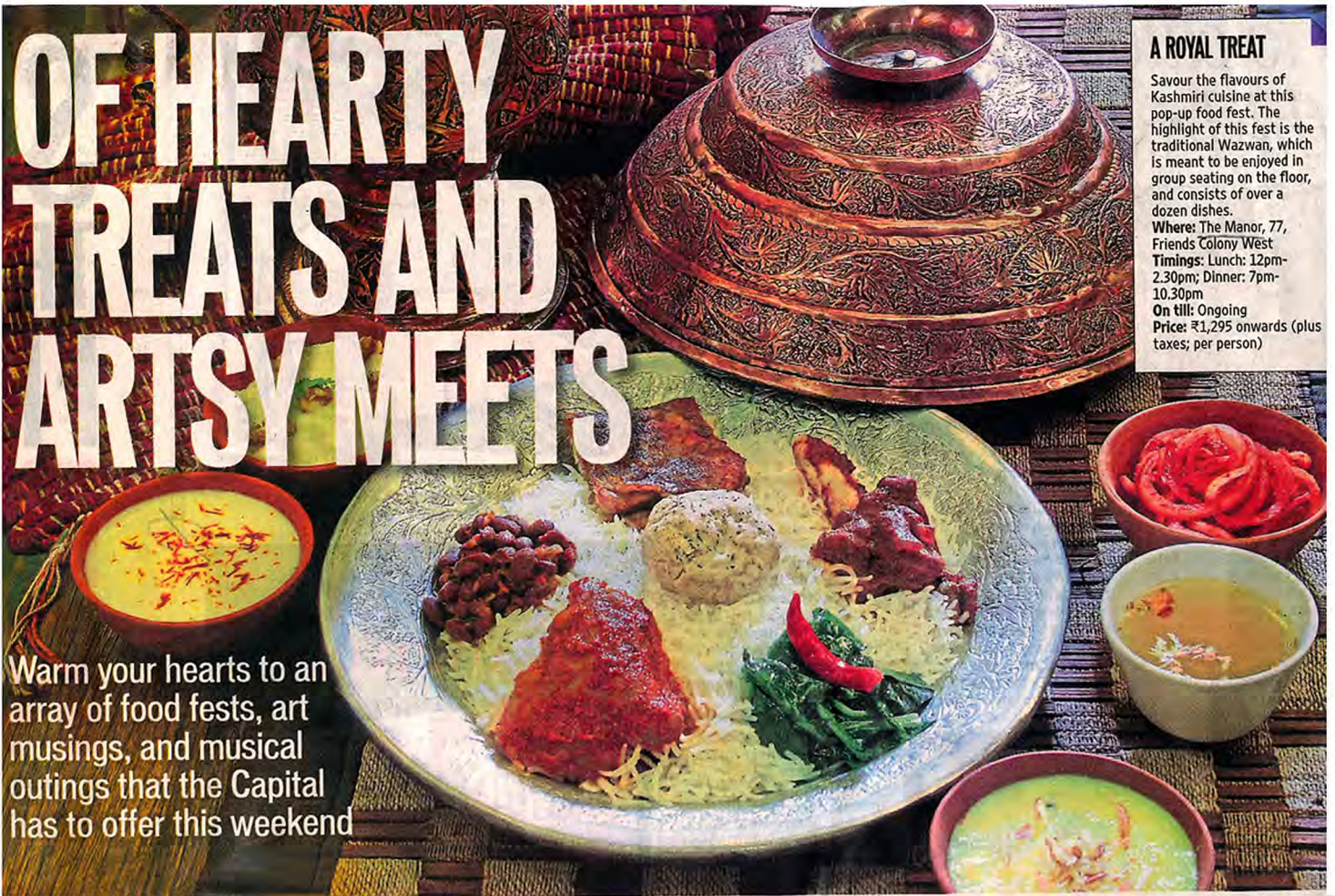


OF HEARTY TREATS AND ARTSY MEETS

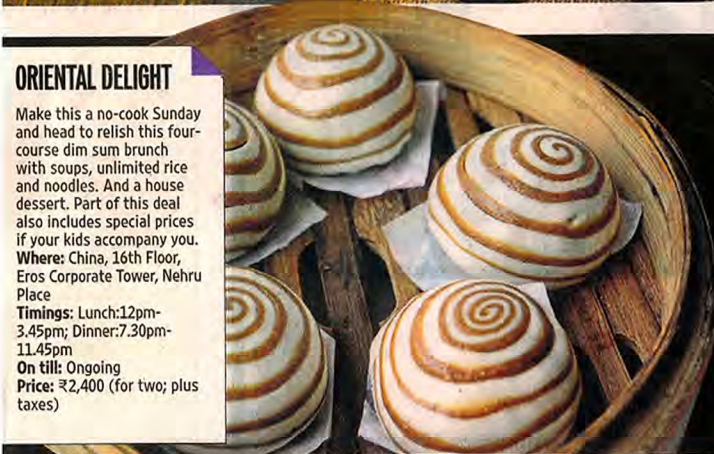
ORIENTAL DELIGHT

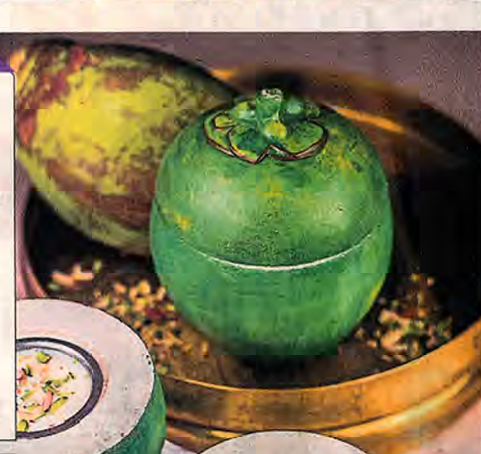


A MELANGE OF COASTAL CUISINES
